Summer Jam Class (offered in conjunction with Groove Dr's)

A less formal short term version of our popular AMP'D performance groups where students put together songs 'on the spot' in a live playing situation. Classes include guitarists, drummers, bassists, keyboardists, and vocalists from the AMP'D teachers alliance. All Jam Classes perform at the Summer Jam Concert on August, 22nd!

Skill Level: Intermediate and up.

Instrument type: Guitars, Drums, Bass, Keys, Vocals

Running Time: One hour per week (10 weeks).

Cost: \$250 due with registration.

Roots of Rock (offered in conjunction with Groove Dr's)

This class is a must for anyone wanting to enter the AMP'D performance group program for the first time. Learn the basics of Rock & Roll Structures, Intro's Endings, Grooves, Solo's and more as you apply the techniques to real songs! Roots of Rock Classes perform at the Summer Jam Concert on August, 22nd!

Skill Level: Intermediate and up.

Instrument type: Guitars, Drums, Bass, Keys, Vocals

Running Time: One hour per week (10 weeks).

Cost: \$250 due with registration.

Guitarobics (various levels - ask your teacher which one is right for you)

Want to improve your speed, accuracy and overall knowledge of the guitar fretboard? Guitarobics will have your fingers in such great shape they'll be sportin' six packs. This nine week course is like boot camp for guitar and just the ticket for turning you into a lean mean playing machine.

Skill Level: Intermediate and up.

Instrument type: Electric & Acoustic Guitar

Running Time: One hour per week (10 weeks).

Cost: \$200 due with registration.

Rock Star's Pro Workout Levels I & II

For professional minded players only! Scale and arpeggio training guaranteed to unlock the mysteries of the entire fretboard. Class focuses on Major and Minor forms of all of the most commonly used scales, modes, and arpeggios. Participants must be recommended by their private teacher and personally admitted by Scott Graves.

Skill Level: Intermediate and up.

Instrument type: Electric, Acoustic, & Classical Guitar

Running Time: One hour per week (10 weeks).

Cost: \$200 due with registration.

Extreme Soloing Levels I & II

This class is designed for guitarists who have already done a great deal of copying solos and are ready for an in depth look at the secrets of creating their own killer lead parts and improvising solos on the fly. Class participants should already have a minimum working knowledge of Pentatonic and Diatonic scale patterns and be comfortable with the basic skills of solo technique (bends, slides, hammers, pulls, etc.).

Skill Level: Advanced Intermediate and up.

Instrument type: Electric Guitar

Running Time: One hour per week (10 weeks).

Cost: \$200 due with registration.
